

## West Jefferson to Jefferson Pedestrian Mobility Feasibility Study

# PUBLIC MEETING



*Town of West Jefferson and Town of Jefferson*

The Towns of West Jefferson and Jefferson, in collaboration with the North Carolina Department of Transportation's Integrated Mobility Division, Blue Ridge Conservancy, and Ashe County, are currently conducting a comprehensive feasibility study. This study aims to assess the potential for a multi-use path from Ridge Avenue in West Jefferson to Academy Street in Jefferson, which will establish a connection for bicyclists and pedestrians from Paddy Mountain to Mount Jefferson as part of the Northern Peaks State Trail.

The proposed multi-use path will begin at Ridge Avenue and travel along N. Jefferson Avenue (NC-194) to 6th Avenue, then to 2nd St/U.S. Highway 221 Business, continuing to Long Street, and ending on Academy Street. The project will also evaluate sidewalk improvements along New River Valley Byway at Medical Park Drive.
